- In December, children from group II, waiting for Christmas, counted down the days as in the Advent calendar, creating a Christmas Nativity scene.



- The teacher and the invited guests read to the children fragments of the book entitled "The Mystery of Christmas". Every day after listening to the story, the children attached to the Nativity Scene the character the story was about.



- After 24 days a beautiful Nativity Scene was created - a common work of the children and the teacher.

- Eager children read aloud to their friends short rhymed stories and then discussed the meaning of each proverb.

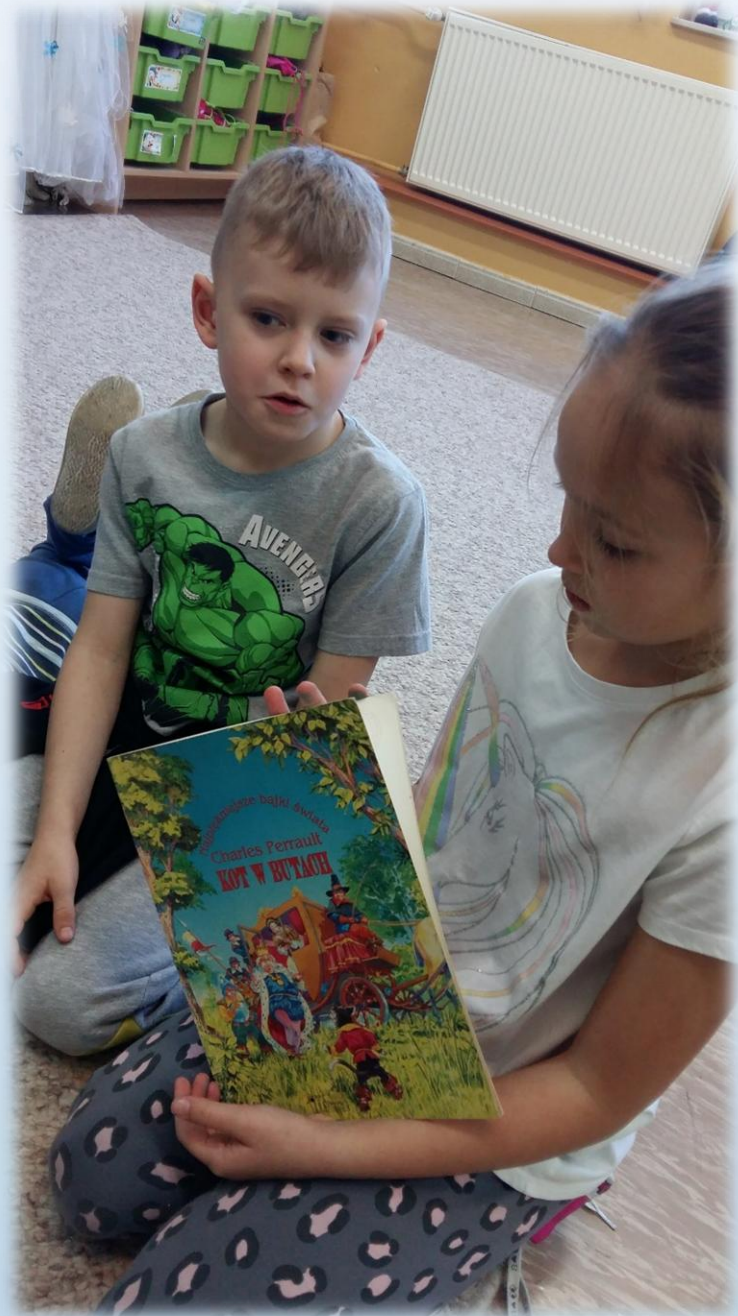

National Reading 2019 in the after-school club

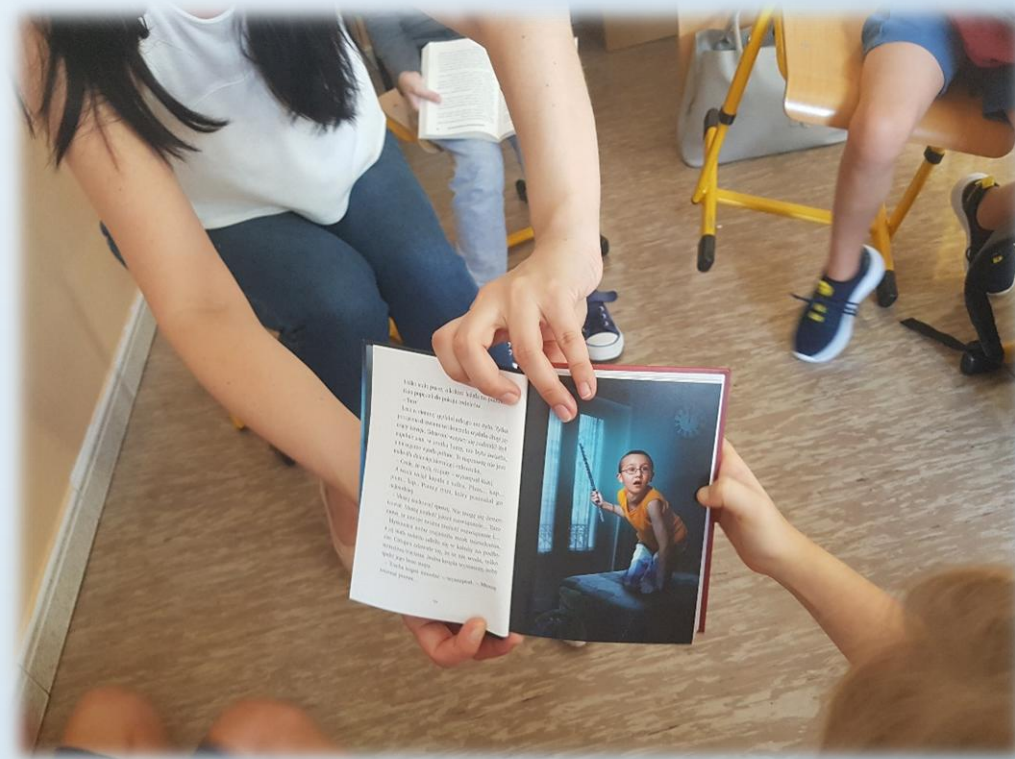
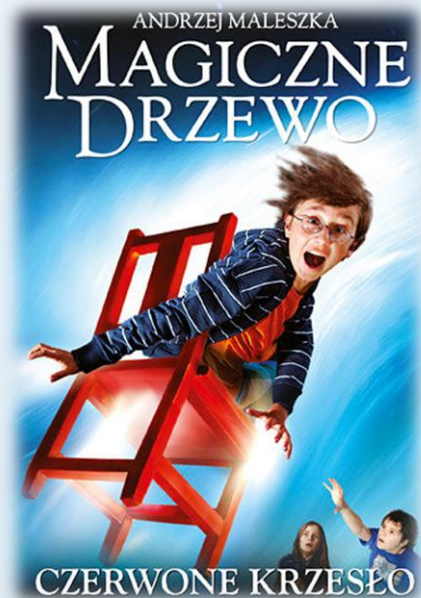
- The National Reading campaign has been organized by the President of Poland since 2012.

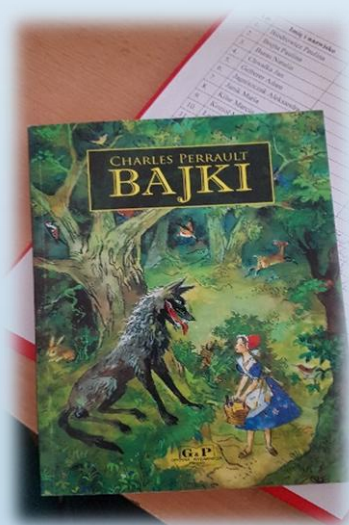

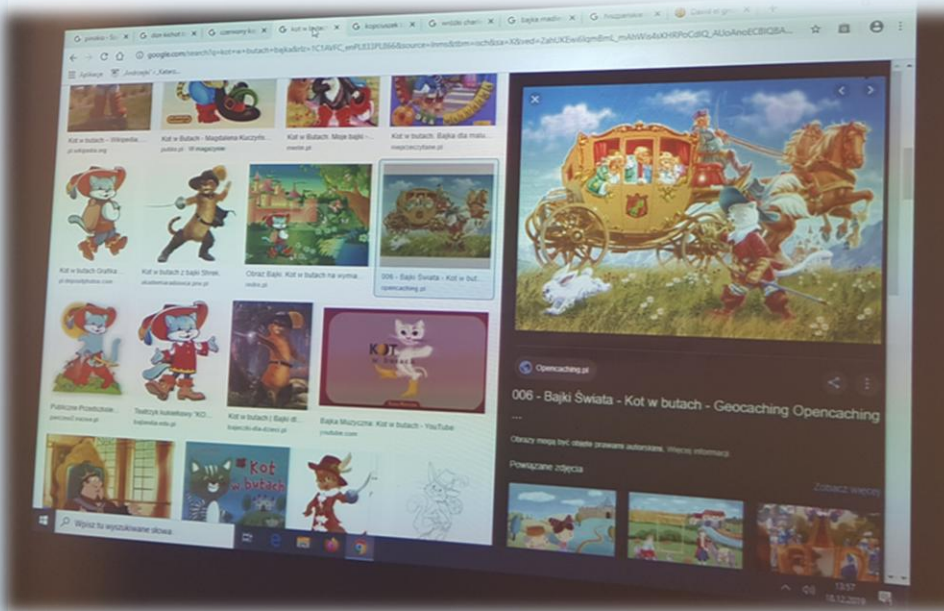
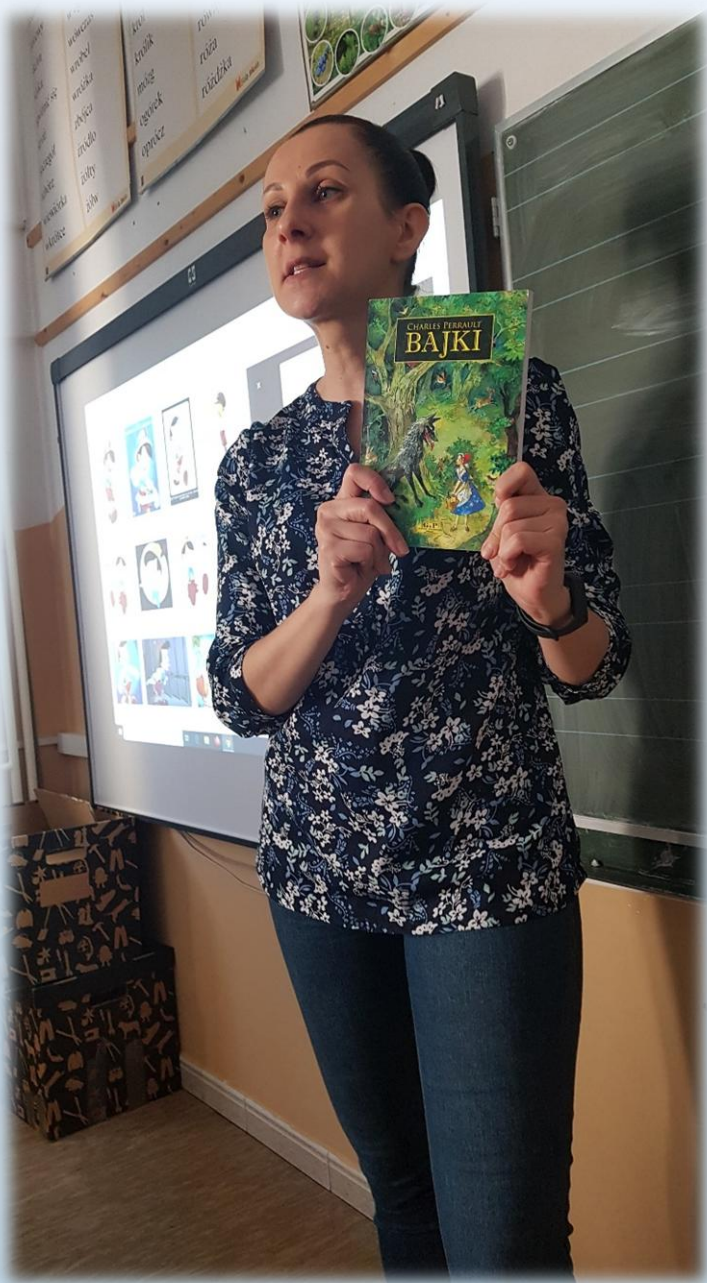

- Children from all groups got to know the legends about Sanok and its surroundings, thus engaging in the project „History hidden in a legend” from the Erasmus + programme.





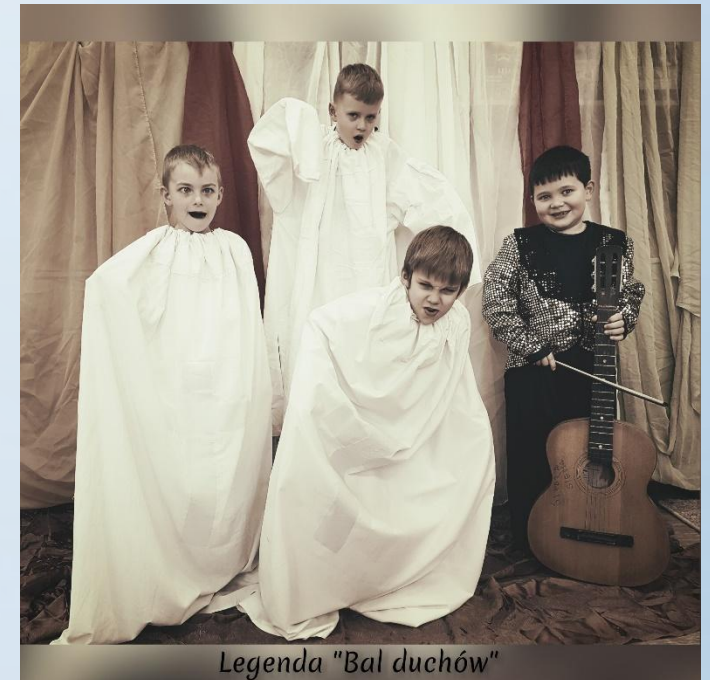
