


SANOK – MY CITY

 Sanok – the city with a population of 40000 inhabitants stretches over an area of 38 km2 and is situated in the southeastern part of the Podkarpackie Province

Open-air museum

The Museum of Folk Architechture in Sanok – the first and the largest ethnographic museum in Poland in terms of the number of collected objects, established after World War II.

Castle in Sanok

 The Royal Castle in Sanok – a castle dating back to the Middle Ages, currently the seat of the Historical Museum, located on Zamkowa Street in Sanok

Arena Sanok

 Arena Sanok – sports and entertainment hall with ice rink in Sanok. The facility is managed by the City Sports and Recreation Centre in Sanok.

Autosan – a brand of Polish buses, once produced in the Sanok Bus Factory "Autosan", and now by Autosan Sp. z o.o. in Sanok.
