

LESSON SCENARIO

SUBJECT:

In ancient Greece

LESSON AIMS:

The pupil

- knows everyday life of ancient Greeks
- knows the rules of sports events in ancient Greece
- knows Greek theatre
- can present his knowledge

TIME:

1*60 minutes

MATERIALS:

- props collected by teacher or prepared by pupils

ORGANISATION OF THE LESSON

The lesson summarizes a chapter devoted to ancient Greece. Before the lesson pupils draw roles they will play during the feast, then they prepare their presentations. They can work alone or in groups of 2-3 people.

THE COURSE OF THE LESSON:

- 1. Teacher explains the aim of the lesson
- 2. Teacher and pupils prepare the classroom
- 3. All pupils sit around one table, props are on the table, every pupil has a card with his name on it
- 4. During the feast pupils eat bread, olives and raisins. **The host** [teacher] begins the feast-greets guests and talks about his house, then he points pupils ,who present the roles they have drawn before.

Proposed characters taking part at the feast

- **Host** [teacher-leads the discussion]
- Child
- Sportsman
- Actor
- Greek woman [housewife]
- Teacher
- 5. The teacher summarises the lesson

6. At the end teacher presents to pupils an eminent Greek historian Polybius. Who created a code known nowadays as "Polybius' Chessboard". Teacher explains the rules of the code and then every pupil gets a coded message and has to decode it
