Students fill the information about the books they read.














These are the students' notebooks.

On the Tree Day we hugged trees. We made a tree, to which we attached leaves with the titles of the books the children had read. The students made the main character - a penguin - from toilet paper rolls.







We also read about space and constellations. The students made models of the solar system.











We also made posters to encourage others to read books.


























The students created the book themselves, wrote the stories, drew the illustrations and published it.





Another task was ecological fashion show.

The classroom was transformed into a fashion designer's workshop. The students designed outfits out of eco-materials with great commitment. Then the effects of their work were presented in a fashion show.



We also take part in a postcard exchange. We write greetings, make illustrations and send cards to other schools in Poland. Recently the children designed the cards themselves.

The children learned interesting facts about water in the human body. They did an experiment comparing the amount of water a person drinks and the amount of water excreted by the body.






Here the pupils smelled, touched and tasted many herbs and spices used in cooking. They learned their names and health values.

During art classes we develop students' creativity. We make artwork using a variety of techniques. We often use eco materials.








































We are constantly trying to make the classes more attractive. We look for new methods of work so that every student can develop, find something interesting for themselves and willingly participate in such activities.
